3-Peanut butter or cheese & Dr 3 granola bars

3-Plastic spoons or forks, wrapped in napkins

3-Individually wrapped moist towelettes (sealed)

Solar blanket

A note with your child's name, address, phone, parent/guardian's names, phone numbers, doctor's phone number.

Please enclose the items in a one-gallon storage bag, with your child's name on the outside. If your child requires daily medication, please contact the school to arrange a method of having the medication
