Dear Northwest Christian School Family,

Next week is a very big week for Northwest Christian School as we host a visiting committee that will fully accredit our school for the next six years. All Adventist schools in our state hold dual accreditation with a gold standard being a full six year term of accreditation. The teachers and the administrative team have been hard at work all year preparing for next week's visit. This effort has produced a 75 page self-study research document and literally hundreds of pages of evidences that profile our schools overall program.

Next week's visiting committee will be conducting a full review of the NCS program including our administrative structures, the schools plans for curriculum, instruction, and assessment as well as our physical plant, staff qualifications and other key indicators of school health. I invite you to join our NCS staff in prayer as next weeks visit will set the tone of education for the next six years at our school. I will be praying specifically for a 6IR, the top ranking that the committee grants to schools.
